

Rules on London Marathon Ballot – Erme Valley Harriers

- Only club members who are paid up and have been a member for 12 months minimum can be entered into the ballot.
- Only those rejected by the London Marathon organisers can be entered into the ballot unless there are more places than those applying. If this happens other members can be considered provided they meet the criteria about membership.
- If a club member is successful in the ballot then he or she will not be allowed to enter the ballot the following year.
- If a club runner withdraws before the deadline for replacements then they must inform the club who will arrange for the first reserve to be put in.
- If a runner withdraws after the cut-off date for replacing an athlete they may defer the place for another year.
- Runners are expected to run in club colours. They may still raise money for charity if they wish
- The ballot will be held at the club's AGM
- The committee's decision is final
