Extract from Andy Trigg's comments on the parkrun scene

This week we had 23 EVH parkrun folk at 8 different locations, including 2 EVH First Visits and 2 volunteers.

There were two EVH First Visits to unique 'industrial' locations. Mike Ho travelled to the inaugural event at Berkeley Green, to protect his recently acquired 'Glouc-set-shire' status. The run is held around the grounds of a disused Magnox nuclear reactor. It's a flat fast 2 lapper. Another, possibly unique, feature is that the car park is inside the course and no one is allowed to drive in or out whilst the parkrun is in progress.

Not to be outdone, the Hansens travelled across the Welsh border to debut at Rogiet parkrun, which is held in a small area of greenery sandwiched between the M4 and the Great Western mainline, right next to the site of the former Severn Bridge toll booths. It's a muddy 3 lapper. Interestingly, the first finisher was CJ of 'Eggheads' fame.

Holland won the Blackmore Vale Lions Half Marathon. He clocked 1:14.42 to finish 11 seconds ahead of Bridport's Ben Renshaw.



Meanwhile in America, **Erme Valley Harriers** steeplechase international **Battershill** has enjoyed an impressive start to 2020.

At the weekend the Harvard University student won the Boston University Bruce Lehane Scarlet and White Invite mile in a personal best time of 4:06.79.

The previous week he had run 4:08.60 for the same distance, which was more than 10 seconds off his previous best, to finish third at the Dr Sander Columbia Challenge in New York.
