DEAR CLUB SPORTSHALL CONTACT

The 2021/22 Devon Sportshall League is due to begin on Sunday 17th October.

The fixture dates are shown on the attached sheet and please note the November meeting is, as usual, the county championship event. This year two fixtures will be held at the Dawlish Leisure Centre and three at the Plymouth Life Centre.

The timetable has been changed slightly from previous years to make the day a little shorter. It will be the same for both Plymouth and Dawlish although it may need to be amended slightly to allow for presentations at the county championship and final fixture.

The affiliation fee remains at £50. The match fees have been increased to £4.00 per athlete (£4.50 for the County Championship meeting). The club affiliation fee should be paid by BACS to Devon County AA before the first fixture, to the following Lloyds Bank account:- Sort Code:- 30-96-06, Account Number:- 02953758.

The amount of athlete match fees due will be notified to each club immediately after each fixture and should be paid by BACS to the above account.

Please note all clubs must provide the EA registration number for athletes in the U13/U15 and U17 age group (this does not apply to U10/U11s). Can I please ask clubs not to register everyone in their club, we only need those who will compete. Additional athletes can be added as the season progresses.

If you register a new athlete who doesn't yet have an EA number then please inform us by the next fixture.
